#### **Archbishop Perez Celebrates Baccalaureate Mass**

The Most Reverend Nelson J. Perez, D.D., Archbishop of Philadelphia, celebrated Baccalaureate Mass for the Bishop Shanahan High School Class of 2021 on Wednesday, June 9 at Saint Joseph Church in Downingtown, PA. Sixteen additional priests concelebrated Mass, representing the students' parishes and extended families. with the Class of 2021. He strongly encouraged them "to be grateful, to be hopeful, to be faithful, and to NEVER underestimate the power of the spirit of God moving in us, through us, and despite us." In addition to this message, students received a special baccalaureate cross during the Mass. The cross serves as a tangible reminder that students will always carry their faith with them, even beyond the halls of Shanahan.

The graduating class included 258 students, all of whom were accepted to four-year colleges including the University of Notre Dame, Drexel University, Rochester Institute of Technology, and Old Dominion University. The class earned more than \$41,000,000 in college scholarships, of which 30 were full tuition scholarships and 92 were presidential scholarships. Sister Maureen Lawrence McDermott, IHM, Ph.D., the Chief Academic Officer and Superintendent of Secondary Schools, presided over the graduation ceremony.

John C. Porter, who will be attending the University of South Carolina, was the valedictorian. Cara Wankmiller, who will be attending the University of Notre Dame, was the salutatorian. to making a positive impact on world hunger. These efforts help Shanahan students to become critical thinkers and moral stewards in a rapidly evolving global environment who respond to the needs and problems around the world.

#### **One Book, One School 2021: Enrique's Journey**

As part of Shanahan's Global Awareness Program, each summer the entire student body reads a specially selected book. Led by faculty, students will analyze and discuss the book in their classes throughout the school year ahead. Students will also have the opportunity to incorporate aspects of the book into unique class projects.

This year's One School, One Book is Enrique's Journey: The Story of a Boy's Dangerous Odyssey to Reunite with His Mother. Enrique's Journey recounts the unforgettable quest of a Honduran boy looking for his mother, eleven years after she is forced to leave her starving family to find work in the United States. Braving unimaginable peril, often clinging to the sides and tops of freight trains, Enrique travels through hostile worlds. But he pushes forward, relying on his wit, courage, hope, and the kindness of strangers.

Shanahan's commitment to global awareness has resulted in an increased ability among students to think critically about complex local and global issues. It also has cultivated empathy and an ethical mindset among students and faculty alike.

Furthermore, an embedded culture of global awareness has allowed students to learn how to exercise their own rights while honoring their responsibilities to others.

### **Ted Torrance Memorial Field Dedication**

O n Friday, March 26th, Bishop Shanahan High School honored the legacy of Mr. Ted Torrance through the dedication of the Ted Torrance Memorial Baseball Field. The event was attended by Mr. Torrance's two sons and their families. The Shanahan community is grateful for all he gave to BSHS. No one has had a longer professional association with Bishop Shanahan High School than Mr.



Torrance, the first lay teacher in the school's history. In the classroom, on the field, and beyond, Mr. Torrance was dedicated to his students and cared deeply about their formation and education. Shanahan is so grateful and he will be dearly missed!

After graduating from Villanova University, Ted served with the U.S. Army in Japan. After serving, Ted joined the founding faculty of Bishop Shanahan, when the school first opened its doors in West Chester in 1957. Ted was the memory and link with the entire Bishop Shanahan High School community from September 1957 onward. He became the first department chair in social studies and his senior government class became a rite of passage for generations of Shanahan graduates. For the next fifty years, Ted was an integral part of the life of BSHS.

Outside of the classroom, Ted was involved with the school's athletic program, and maintained that involvement through the years. He organized and coached the school's first cross country team and went on to earn one of the most impressive records in the history of high school athletics in Chester County. For fourteen years, Ted served as the varsity boys' baseball coach, and also helped to coach football, basketball, and track. Eventually, his interest in athletics led him to become a sportswriter for the Daily Local News. In 2011 Mr. Torrance was inducted into the Ches-Mont League Hall of Fame, and in 2016 he was inducted into the Chester County Sports Hall of Fame.

Off the playing field, Ted gave his time to a broad range of student activities. One of these included the "Hillside Singers," a folk group during the folk craze of the 1960's, as well as advising the school's mock trial team, and serving as one of the school's earliest Directors of Development. For many years, Ted also joined other Shanahan teachers in leading student summer tours of Europe. All the while, Ted and his wife Marlene were raising a young family of two sons and a daughter, who themselves went on to become Shanahan graduates.

Ted Torrance retired from the classroom in 2007 after fifty years of uninterrupted and dedicated service. Retirement from the classroom did not bring to a close his loyalty, devotion, or service to Bishop Shanahan, as Ted accepted the position of full-time Athletic Director. This commitment placed Ted in charge of almost 500 student athletes each season and 25 Varsity PIAA sports.

In 2004, Ted was a Shanahan Medal Award Recipient in recognition of his lifetime of service to Catholic education. In 2008 he was a BSHS Golden Anniversary Gala Honoree. The Shanahan community celebrated with Ted and his family 50 years of dedication to his students and his school. Everyone in Chester County knew and respected "Ted Torrance."

Mr. Torrance was a man of few words, yet his daily, unwavering presence and his genuine love of all things green and white, all things Shanahan, spoke louder than any word or phrase.

### 2nd Annual Shanahan Summer Strides

O ver the summer, Shanahan happily hosted the 2nd Annual Shanahan Summer Strides competition! This virtual walk/run was open to students, parents, faculty, staff, alumni, community friends, and their families. The competition began on the Fourth of July and ran through Labor Day, encouraging participants to run or walk 64 miles. Each of the 64 miles represented a BSHS graduating class from 1958 to 2021, and funds raised supported BSHS students in need of financial aid.

Participants diligently logged their miles each week online, and were rewarded for their efforts by being named the winner of a weekly challenge. Weekly Challenges this year included: alumni year with most total miles, group with most total miles, group with most total participants, individual/group with highest average miles, and the best picture/social media post. At the conclusion of the event, the weekly challenge winners and other remarkable competitors were sent limited edition Shanahan Summer Strides medals.

Since the inaugural year in 2020, Shanahan Summer Strides has raised \$16,027 by 248 participants. Shanahan extends a big "thank you" to all Shanahan Striders from last year AND this year for helping to make it a growing new tradition at BSHS. Learn more at shanahan.org/strides!


