New Academic Programs Launched at Bishop Shanahan

BSHS excitedly launched two new robust academic programs this fall: STEM Pathways and the Eagle Business Academy. These programs provide opportunities for more students to participate in a specialized learning experience that includes collaborative research, workshops, competitions, mentoring, and college counseling — all focused in STEM and business.



STEM Pathways

STEM Pathways inspires the next generation of innovators by empowering students to be creative, collaborative and critical-thinking problem solvers. This program takes an interdisciplinary approach to learning, where rigorous academic concepts are coupled with real-world applications. The program ensures all BSHS students graduate with fluency in basic STEM literacy and provides a pathway to success in college, career and beyond.

There is an exciting curriculum ahead for STEM Pathways. Some

of the classes include Information Technologies, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Bio-engineering, and Website Technologies. In addition to a core group of classes that progress with each grade level, many students attend a STEM Speaker Series and take electives such as Database Development for Real World Programs, Computer Game Development and Understanding Artificial Intelligence.

"Since the program explores a variety of mathematics principles and sciences," shared one student, "I can use what I've learned within the program to create a better idea of what I'd like to do in the future and possibly the work it demands."

At the conclusion of sophomore year, students who express a particular interest and aptitude in STEM will be invited to apply for the STEM Certificate Program. Students who successfully complete



the STEM Certificate Program will graduate with an official certificate denoting their participation in the program and their advanced proficiency in STEM.

The Eagle Business Academy

The Eagle Business Academy is a four-year academic pathway that addresses college and career readiness skills. Students gain knowledge in the business field and cover all high school prerequisites for acceptance into competitive post-secondary institutions. Graduates will leave pre-

pared to commit to business as developed leaders in the ever-changing global economy.

This program empowers students in the development of key skills including critical thinking, problem solving, research, reading, writing, speaking, presenting, teamwork, analyzing, reasoning, negotiating, and questioning.

The rigorous courses enable students to apply these skills while identifying how the material connects to other academic disciplines. Students learn about roles, responsibilities and career paths of specific professions. This includes exposure to careers both in the classroom and, in the future, through workplace visits. Course offerings include everything from Introduction to Business through Principles of Management, Java Programming, Proposal Writing, and more.

30 Day Happiness Challenge

Bishop Shanahan has a rich tradition of excellence, achieved by a willingness to embrace new strategies to academically and spiritually prepare young adults for the future. Despite the challenges of COVID-19, Shanahan's fall curriculum does not hold back on the school's plans to launch new faith programs to help students cope with difficulties and instill hope.

For the 2020-2021 school year, Shanahan will participate in Magnify: 30 Day Happiness Challenge. This virtual program blends emotional wellness with spirituality through scripture readings, reflections and peer-topeer discussions that broaden perspectives. Throughout the 30 days, students will experience concepts designed to create hope and decrease anxiety. Funding for Magnify was made available through a grant from the Ambassador's Fund for Catholic Education.

Bishop Shanahan continues to raise the bar to ensure students have the tools they need to achieve their future goals. The commitment to excellence has not been compromised during COVID-19. The mission of Bishop Shanahan High School remains strong due to the unwavering efforts of faculty, staff and students. Now more than ever, the school continues to "Seek The Things That Are Found Above."

Lauren Garrett's Inspirational Story

fter a cheerleading stunt accident left junior Lauren Garrett seriously injured Aand initially unable to move from the waist down, she had a long road to recovery ahead of her. She was in intensive care for a week and was then transferred to a rehabilitative floor of the hospital with a burst fracture in her spine on the first lumbar vertebra. Fortunately it was all impact injury and there was no puncturing.

Now Lauren has two rods and five levels fused. She continues daily rehabilitation and physical therapy. Part of her recovery also includes botox injections every three months in her calf muscles to loosen them. Once she was ready, Lauren returned to school three days a week full time, and two days a week part time. Using a wheelchair and later crutches, she carefully navigated the building with the help of friends, staff and her physical therapist.

Celebrating her inspirational story of recovery, Lauren had the opportunity to throw out the ceremonial first pitch for the Phillies opener when less than a year ago, she was in intensive care. Congratulations on all your accomplishments, Lauren! BSHS is so proud of you! God bless you!

Doug Costin '16 Signs with Jacksonville Jaguars

Bishop Shanahan High School congratulates alumnus Doug Costin, Class of 2016, who signed with the Jacksonville Jaguars of the NFL! God bless you on this wonderful accomplishment!

Tormer Bishop Shanahan defensive tackle P Doug Costin signed a free agent contract with the Jacksonville Jaguars after a stellar career at Miami University (Ohio). Costin was a three year starter in college and was named first-team all-Mid American Conference in 2019. Costin recorded 58 tackles and four sacks in 2019, and for his career, he played 50 games and registered 178 tackles and 17 sacks.

Costin's high school head coach at Bishop Shanahan, Paul Meyers, talked about Costin, who is the first former Eagle to play in the NFL. "Doug is a great kid who works hard, is humble and is a student of the game," Meyers said. "His athleticism will help him make the team. He can play defensive tackle as well as special teams. I am so happy for him."

Costin said his time as an Eagle helped him



on and off the field. "Coming out of middle school I was a little childish," Costin said. "I feel Bishop Shanahan really prepared me for college both on and off the field. I really feel it was important to be ready for life after football because football will be over some time."

Coach Meyers reached out to Doug for an update regarding his NFL experience amid the COVID-19 pandemic. We are grateful to Doug for this update, and share his words of wisdom with current students and alumni:

"This season will be the furthest thing from normal, but I am still blessed to be able to wake up every day and play the game that I love for a living.

Some words of wisdom I would share with the current team are to find comfort with being uncomfortable and give it everything you have. What I mean by that is learn to love the pain and hard times that come with playing football. These uncomfortable things could be conditioning, lifting or just having a bad day at school. Not only will it help you in football, but it will also help you become a better person outside of the sport as well.

Football has taught me many life lessons and has helped shape me into the person I am today. Remember to have fun while playing football. I have been playing since I was in second grade and I believe this is the thing that has made it such a passion for me. Through all the hard times and upsetting moments football has brought, I have never once stopped having fun playing."

McNulty '16 a New Breed of Long-Stick Midfielder

oyola Maryland lacrosse coach Charley ▲ Toomey already knew that Bishop Shanahan's Ryan McNulty was a gifted player, but it was the stories about his involvement in the community which made him stand out.

There was one in particular when McNulty befriended a female classmate with Asperger's syndrome. He would take her to dinner or out socially on the weekends to make her feel comfortable with her classmates, who sometimes made her feel awkward.

Being unselfish is what makes McNulty successful on the field as well. He isn't just a good long-stick midfielder but maybe the best in college lacrosse. These are the guys that do all the dirty work like gobbling up ground balls or shutting down the opposition's top midfielder.



When drills get sloppy, McNulty has the green light to call a timeout and adjust the tempo. If a teammate is dropping too many passes, he'll probably hear a few words from McNulty. After red shirting as a freshman because of a foot injury, McNulty still has one more year of eligibility left.

He is in position to be a captain for three straight years.

"Early in his career he would speak to

teammates and hold guys accountable, and that is what you are looking for," Toomey said. "I love the way he goes about his business and speaks his mind. But he is also the first one to run up to you and put his arm around you."

McNulty is his own man. Few players his age have his spirit or maturity, and he is actively involved with several ministries on campus.

Usually on Thursday he can be found in Baltimore with team chaplain Father Timothy Brown delivering food to the homeless on the streets or at homeless shelters.

Last year alone, Ryan was named to the national Tewaaraton Award Watch List, the Preseason All-Patriot League Team, and the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year! Congratulations, Ryan!

Alumnae Fulfill Childhood Pact to Dance at THON

hen they were 12 years old, Lauren Saello '16 and Rebecca Reeves '16 made the trip to Penn State with Lauren's father, United Way of Chester County CEO Chris Saello, to cheer on the student dancers at THON.

THON is Penn State's 46-hour dance marathon run completely by students. It's the largest student-run philanthropy in the world and raises money for the Four Diamonds Fund at the Penn State Children's Hospital in Hershey. The fund pays medical bills for families with a child battling cancer.

That day, as they watched the student dancers complete the marathon, Lauren and Rebecca made a pact that they would someday dance in THON together.

Years later, the two Bishop Shanahan grads became Penn State students. After not getting picked in the lottery to dance in 2019, they decided to try one more time as seniors.

After raising almost \$15,000 over the past two years, their numbers were finally drawn in their final semester of college.



Lauren and Rebecca took the floor at the Bryce Jordan Center with 705 other dancers to fulfill the pact they made almost a decade earlier and complete the grueling 46 hours with no sleep and no sitting.



Lauren and Rebecca decided to dance in honor of Liam Kane (pictured), the son of Chris Saello's college roommate, Kevin Kane of Garnet Valley,



who also danced at THON in 1988. Kane lost Liam to childhood cancer in 2005 when he was five years old.

During the marathon, Lauren and Rebecca wore shirts that showcased Liam's dinosaur artwork and said "childhood cancer should be extinct." The Downingtown natives both graduated in May, with Lauren earning a bachelor's degree in Event Planning and Rebecca earning hers in Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Services.
