## Additional Information about the BSHS Health and Safety Plan

### Modified Attendance

Since we are encouraging parents to monitor health closely, and we also encourage keeping students home if they display symptoms, the grading of attendance has changed. Students will be marked as attending in-person or attending virtually. Only when a student cannot or does not participate in any of the virtual lessons, will they be marked absent.

### BSHS Face Masks

Since face coverings and masks have become regularized, we have added a BSHS face mask to the school uniform. Each student will receive two complimentary face masks on the first day of school. Families who wish to order additional BSHS face masks may do so by [clicking here](#). Additional details about the masks are:

- 4.5 oz (US) 7.5 oz (CA), ring spun cotton
- 2-ply, tight knit jersey
- Trim and ear loops made from 100% ring spun cotton-covered elastic
- Pleated chin for stay-put fit
- Is treated with an antimicrobial agent that contains silver to control odors

### Green and White Group Assignments

The students will be assigned Green and White groups. The group will be indicated on the roster as A or B. If you are assigned A, you are the Green group, and B is the White group. On the calendar if it says green day, the green group is reporting to school and the white group is attending classes virtually. Siblings have been assigned the same group unless the family requested to have different groups on the family surveys.

### Water Bottles and Backpacks

Students will be allowed to carry their backpacks during the school day in order to reduce the usage of lockers in between classes. Phones should be placed in their lockers and be turned off during the school day. Water fountains have been converted to water bottle filling stations. Students may carry water bottles with them throughout the school day.
